

Six to Twelve Months

- Have your family help you compile a guest list.
- Set a budget.
- Choose and secure reception location.
- Set appointment with Officiant.
- Select your best man, groomsman and ushers (one per every 50 guests).
- Plan the honeymoon.

Four to Two Months

- Purchase wedding rings and order the engraving.
- Secure entertainment for the wedding.
- Choose formal wear for yourself and your groomsman this includes tuxedos, vests, shoes, cufflinks, ascots, ties, formal socks, etc.
- Make sure all measurement cards are sent in at least one month before the wedding.
- Organize wedding day transportation this includes transportation from the ceremony to the reception site, to the wedding night accommodations and the honeymoon.
- Coordinate accommodations & transportation for out-of-town guests and attendants.
- Arrange wedding night accommodations.
- Make reservations for rehearsal dinner.
- Buy a special gift to give your bride on the wedding day.
- Buy gifts for the groomsman.

One to Two Weeks

- Arrange to move your belongings to your new home
- Pickup wedding rings
- Plan bachelor party or dinner
- Confirm rehearsal dinner with all attendees
- Pickup formalwear
- Give best man the clergy fee in sealed envelope so he can take care of at the ceremony.
- Appoint a groomsman to return everyone's rented formal wear.
- Help write thank-you notes with your bride.
- Pack for honeymoon
